Preliminary Round Games are based on the five (5) point system:

- 1 point awarded for period won
- 1/2 point per period tied
- 0 points for period lost
- 2 points for game won
- 1 point for games tied
- 0 points for games lost

Points accumulated by period will determine the 1st through 4th place teams for play in the Semi-Final Round. In the event of a tie in points after the three games, the team who allowed the least overall goals will be declared the winner. If that is also a tie, the team with the least penalty minutes totaled from all 3 games will be declared the winner. If the two teams remain tied, the team who scored earliest in their inaugural tournament game will advance.
